

# Syllabus for HIMT360

## Healthcare II: Survey of Disease and Treatments

---

**NOTE:** This syllabus document contains the basic information of this course. The most current syllabus is available in the full course.

### Course Description

This course further investigates the topics covered in HIMT 330 Health Care I. On the basis of each body system, the course will further expand into the topics of human disease and health issues. The course is composed of three main sections. The first section (Sessions 1 through 8) addresses fundamental body function, especially as the body responds to defend against tissue damage. The second section (Sessions 9 through 15) will focus on prevalent diseases of major organ systems. The third section will highlight major approaches to disease prevention, maintenance, and treatment. Students are expected to review course materials, analyze relevant figures and data, and present complete answers to quiz questions.

### Prerequisite(s)

HIMT 330 Healthcare I: Terminology and Body Systems

### Course Outcomes

At the conclusion of this course, you will be able to:

- Explain hundreds of terms and concepts related to human disease.
- Apply knowledge of human disease terms to current healthcare issues.

### Course Requirements/Components

#### Problem Sets

The bulk of your work for the course involves completing problem sets based on your reading of *The Nature of Disease* and your comprehension of video lectures. Each of the 20 sessions of the course requires you to complete problem

sets that you will find in the form of quizzes. Typically, there are three quizzes that form one problem set for a session. The first quiz is meant to assess your recall and understanding of key terms, the second quiz assess your understanding of the session's contents, and the third quiz focuses on your application of the session content.

The quizzes within a session total 20 points, and there are 20 sessions in the course.
